

are an opportunity to share ideas and resources, build relationships and access more learning opportunities around your subject.



Interest Groups Online (IGO) is a digital u3a community that gives you the opportunity to join groups, talks and courses from the comfort of your home.

There are about 118 groups, many waiting list only, but enough with spaces to make it worth a look.

You must be registered and pay for IGO separately. It won't affect your normal Lewes u3a membership. Annual membership is £12, covering the period from 1st April 2024 to 31st March 2025. If you join after 1st October, the fee is reduced to £6.



Join Interest Groups Online



From a management perspective,
PayPal is the most efficient way to
receive payments from members
for membership and group
enrolment. But many are hesitant
to use this—decades old -payment
technology, feeling they will be
'duped' into joining something they
do not wish to.

PayPal itself says: 'PayPal's guest checkout option allows users to pay with a debit or credit card without creating a PayPal account. PayPal will process the payment even if you don't have an account'.

Paypal will take your credit or debit card details when you pay and that will be enough. You will not be required to join PayPal, although it will give you the option to do so when you checkout.

If you do have a PayPal account, you can sign in and PayPal will deduct the money from whatever account you signed into PayPal. It's a quicker process, but only works if you have actually joined PayPal.

LEWES u3a SUBSCRIPTION RENEWALS



Are you aware that there is only *one* renewal date for Lewes u3a?

Thank you for those members who have paid the annual membership fee in the past few weeks.

There are members who may not realise that, no matter what time of year you join Lewes u3a, the renewal date is September each year.

This means, for example, that if you joined in June 2023, your renewal is due on 1st September 2023, then September 2024 and so on. Very often there is a reduced fee if you join mid-year, but the full fee is due at the next renewal date (September).

Gideon Mantell, one time inhabitant of Lewes and local doctor. He is perhaps better known for his interest in Geology and his discovery of the bones and teeth of the Iguanodon. His paper on this giant reptile, one of the very first dinosaurs to be identified, was published in

February 1825.
